

11. Total cost of the hydrant and installation will be paid prior to initiation or installation. Money to be placed in Escrow; to be paid to the installer after inspection and approval of District Manager.

JANUARY 8, 1986

Returned checks: Fee for checks returned marked Insufficient Funds will be raised from \$10.00 to \$15.00, and that returned checks must be picked up and paid for in cash, money order or cashier's check at the District office.

NOVEMBER 5, 1987

Check valve in meter to keep contamination from entering our lines and the benefit owner must provide a relief valve and be responsible.

MAY 5, 1988

Any time Rural Water District #7 is forced to make a road boring for the setting of a water tap, it will be at the customers' expense.

JULY 5, 1990

All water loss which occurs as a result of a leak on the customers' side of the meter will be calculated at the current rate up to the amount charged by the Water District for a Benefit Unit. All water loss exceeding said amount will be calculated at the rate paid by the Water District to its supplier plus pumping cost.

OCTOBER 4, 1990

Any removal of a locking device on a meter will be an automatic fine of \$300.00.

FEBRUARY 4, 2021

The current \$15.00 monthly membership fee will increase to \$20.00 beginning on the July 1st billing.

JULY 6, 2023

The monthly membership fee on a 1" meter will be \$60.00 per month.

FEBRUARY 1, 2024

Open Records Act Policy

MAY 2, 2024

RV Parks – All RV Parks will be supplied by ¾" or a 1" meter whichever is determined appropriate by the district with the monthly membership fee and total monthly usage calculated in the usual manner, the same as all other members. In addition, a fee of \$6.00 per parking spot; filled or vacant will be charged on a monthly basis along with the monthly bill.

JULY 5, 2024

The Rural Water District will add a \$35 trip fee to accounts that a trip is made to lockout, but the customer makes arrangements for payment that day in lieu of lockout.

SEPTEMBER 5, 2024

The cost of the membership for a 1" meter will be \$3000.00.

DECEMBER 5, 2024

Flush Hydrant Policy replacing the July 2,1986 policy.

Hydrants are placed wherever the District determines is necessary or beneficial for the District.

Hydrants must meet the design and installation criteria of District 7 Engineer

Hydrants may be removed as a consequence of damage, neglect, or abuse.

Hydrants are the property of the District

Hydrants are normally closed via isolation valve
